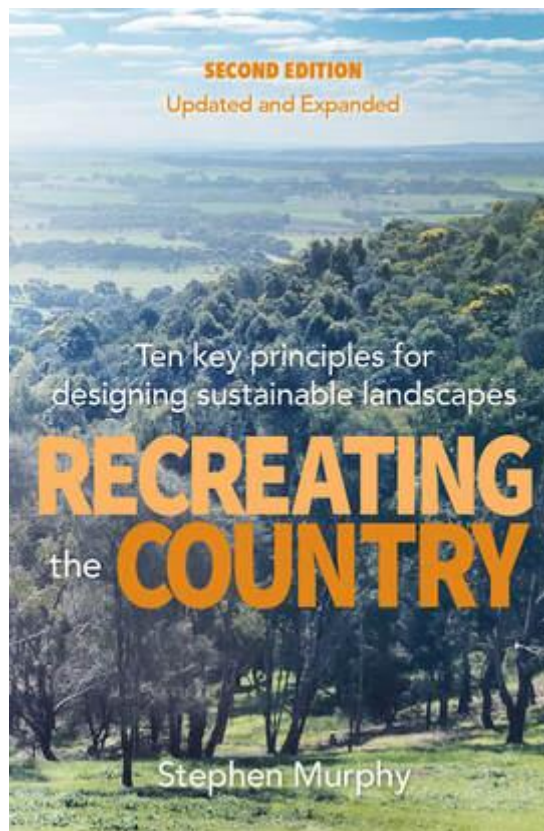


19 May, Sunday - a very special day with Stephen Murphy on Sustainable Biorich Landscapes at 'Kolora'
